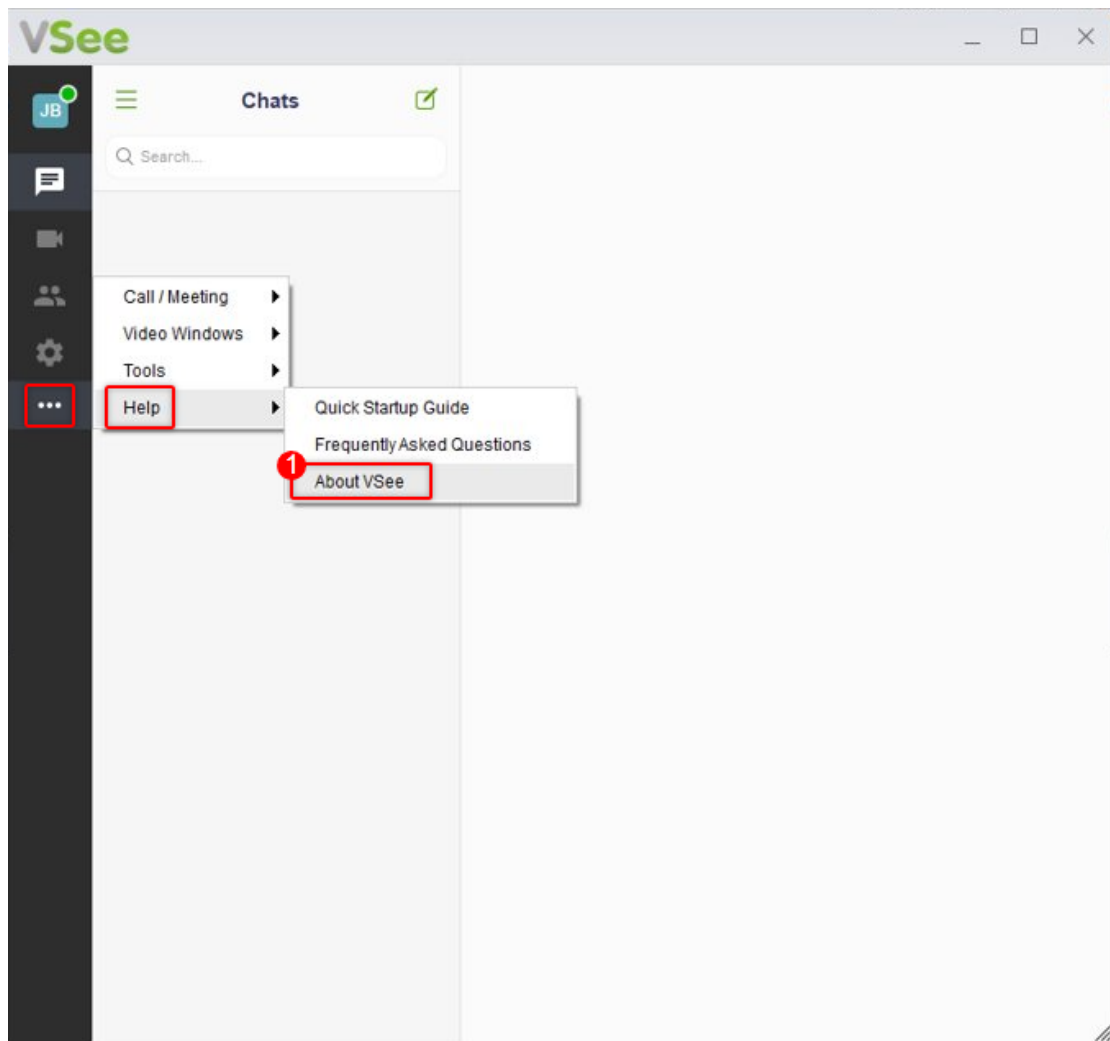

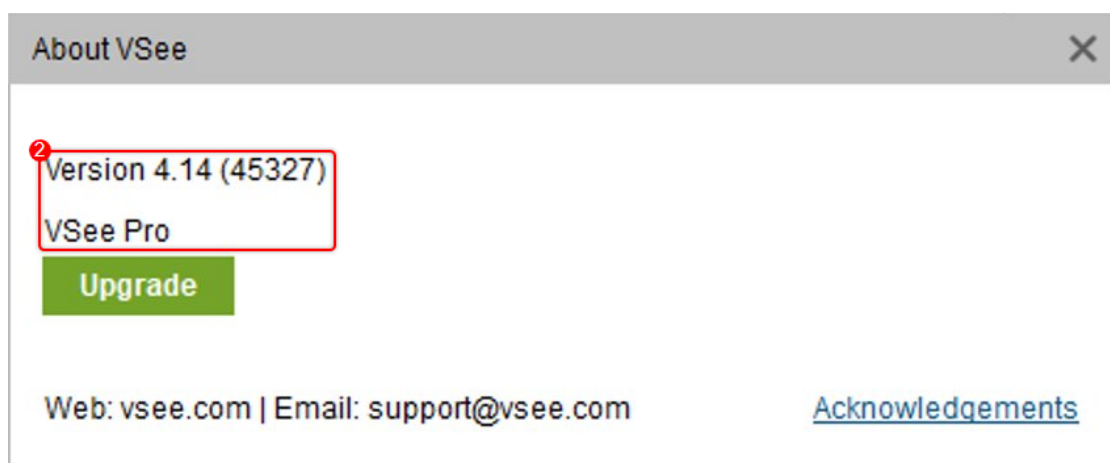
### Windows

Open the VSee Messenger app. Please make sure you are logged in using the correct email address.

1. Click on the Ellipsis (...) > Help > About VSee.



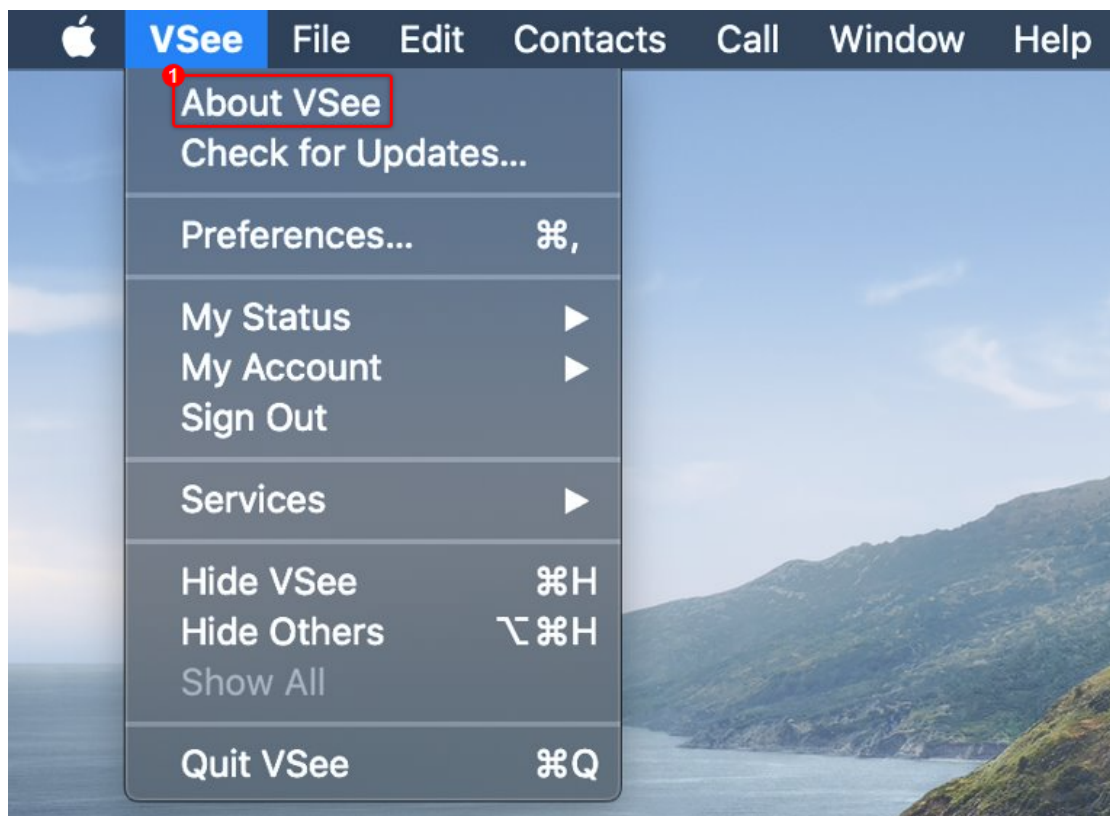
2. Your device's current app **version** and **build number** [eg 4.14 (45327)] and your account's **subscription plan** (eg VSee Pro) will be shown.



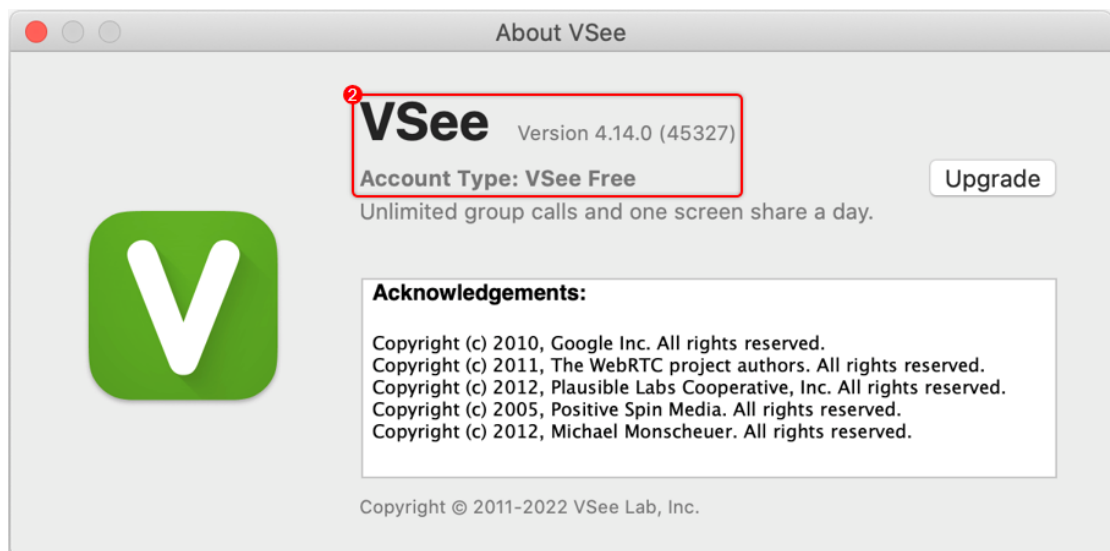
## Mac

1. With the VSee App open and its window active, click **VSee** on the top

menu bar. Select **About VSee**.



2. Your device's current app **version** and **build number** [eg 4.14.0 (45627)] and your account's **subscription plan** (eg VSee Free) will be shown.
