

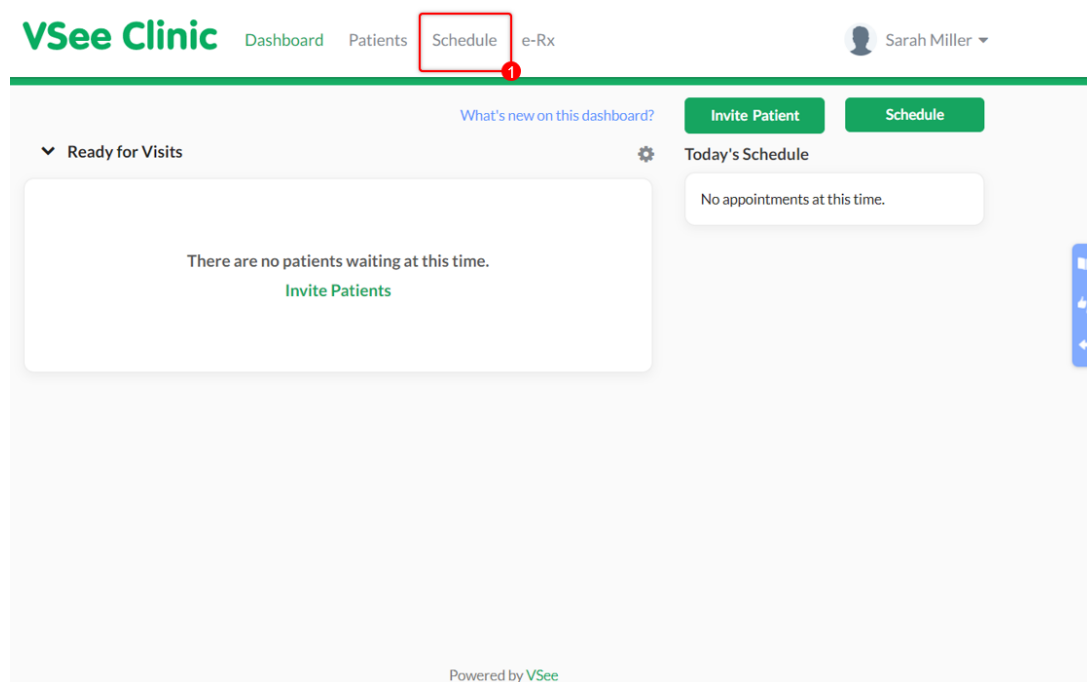
How to Create Visit Slots

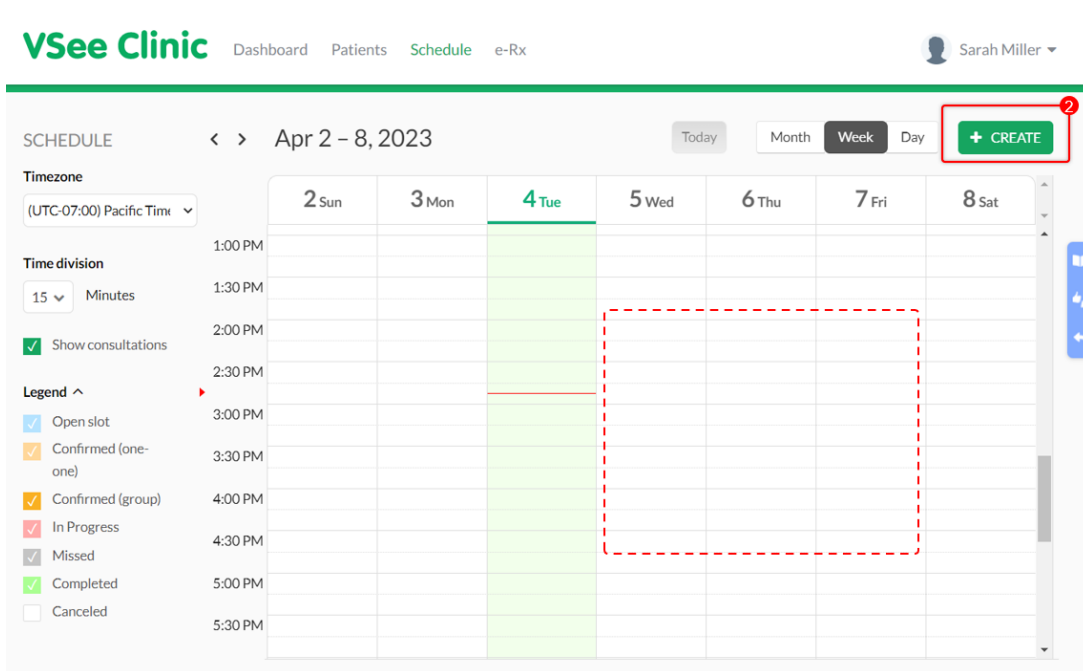

Set Up your Visit Time Slots

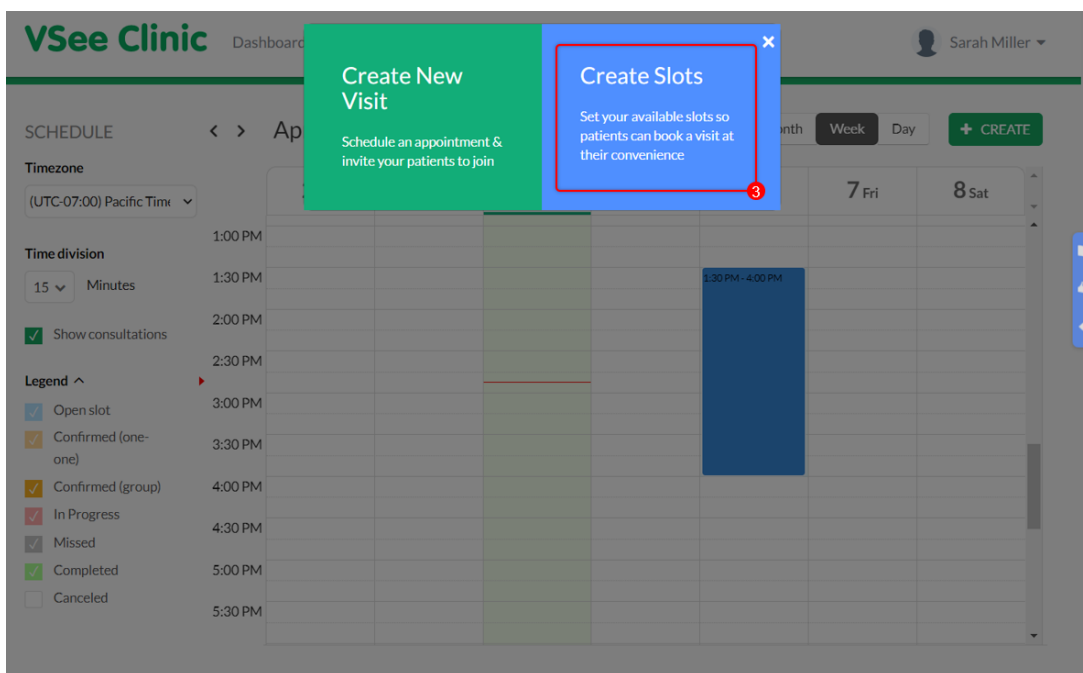
1. On your provider dashboard, click the **Schedule** tab from the top menu.



2. Click the **+Create** button or click and drag on the calendar for your available visit time slots.



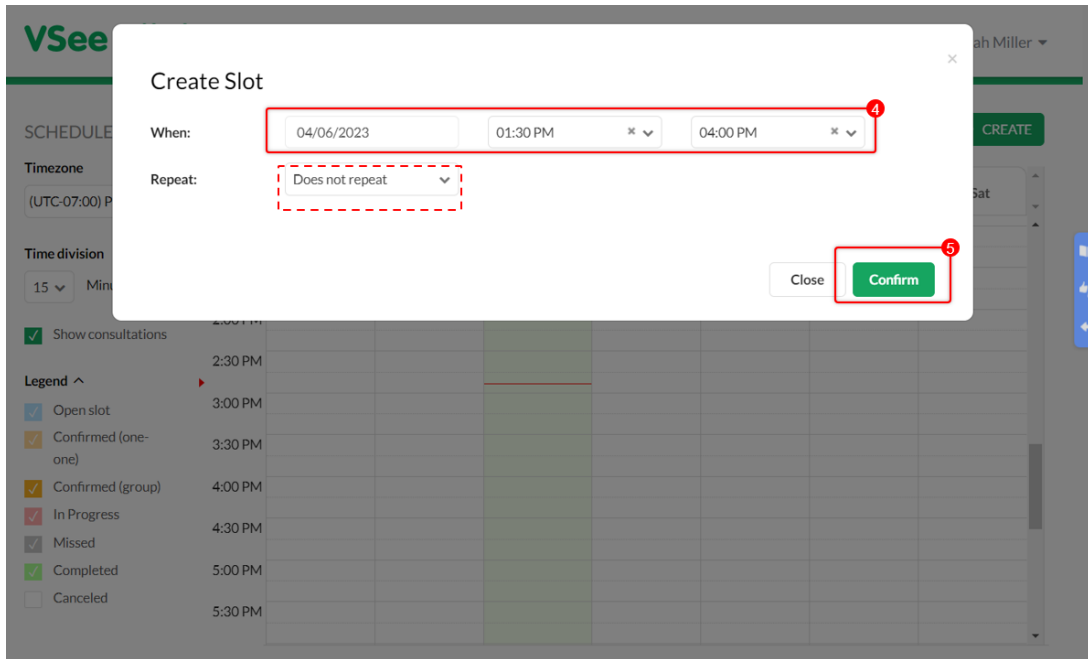
3. Then select **Create Slots**.



4. Specify the start date, then the start time and end time of your preferred time slots.

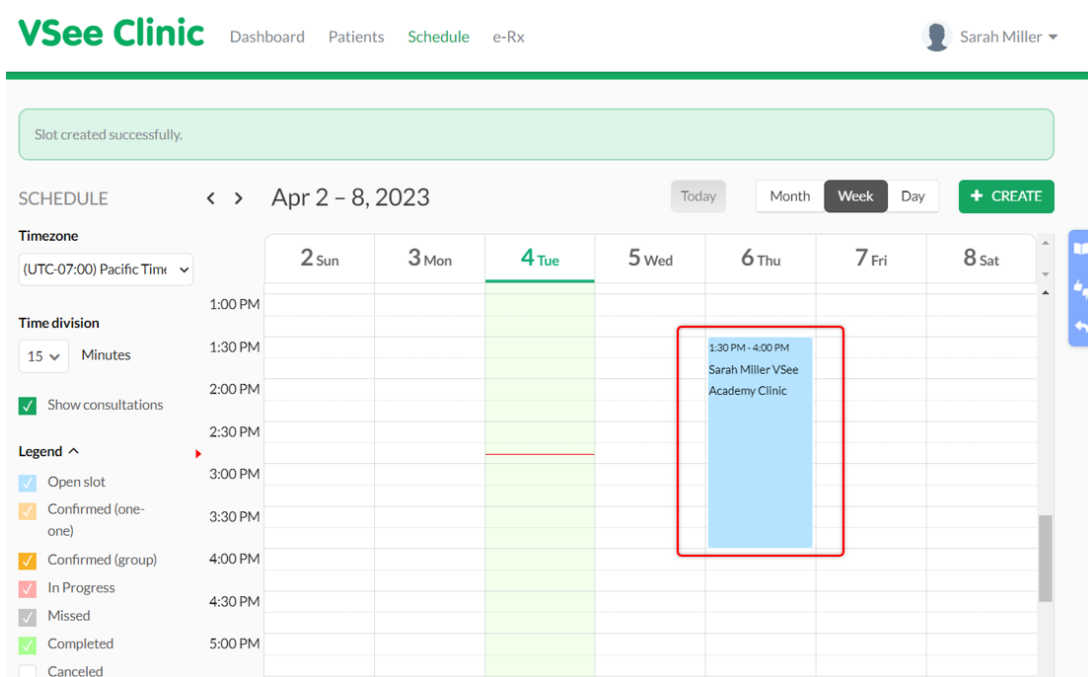
You can customize and set it to repeat on specific days of the week.

5. Click **Confirm** to save.
