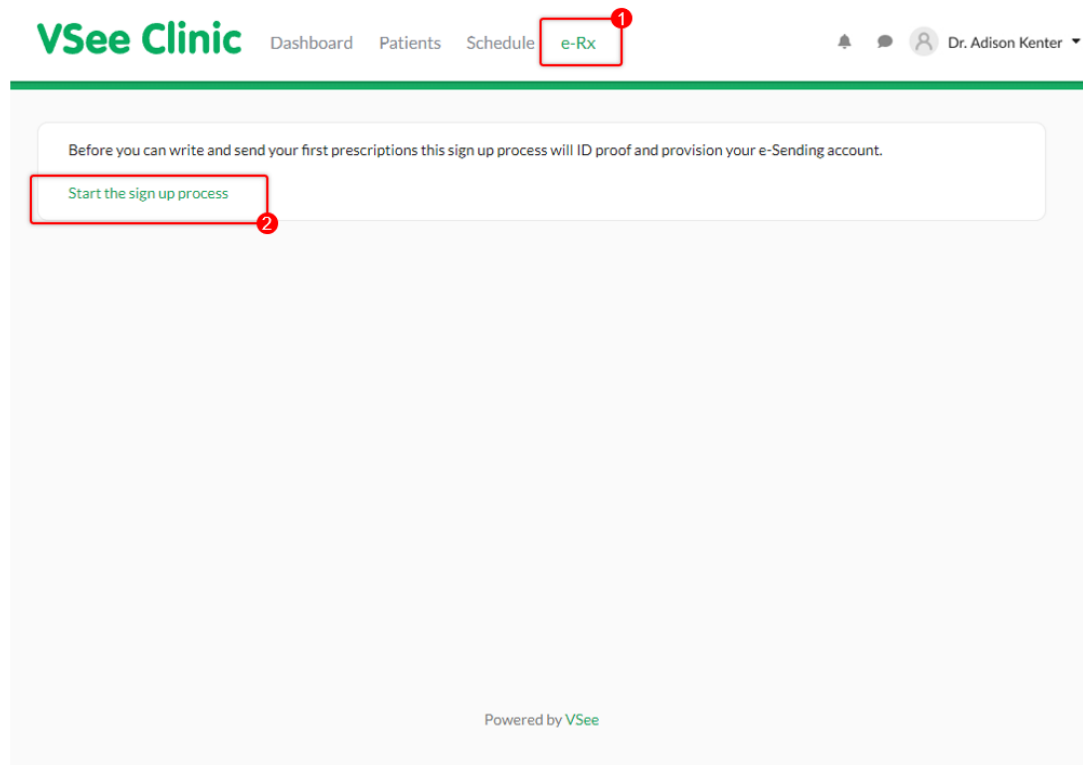
Once everything is done, our Admin will send you a notification email saying that the eRx is now enabled in your clinic and you can proceed to login and register in the eRx tab.
