How to View a Patient's Visit Page



Often times, Providers need to review their Patients' details during or right after the call. However, it takes extra clicking if the appointment made is a group appointment. With the new Visit page, it is a lot easier to jump from one Patient's details to another.

Below are the steps on how you can access the Profile details of your Patients through Patient's Visit Page.


How to View Patient's Profile Details from the Visit Page

1. From an open Patient's Visit Page, click the **ellipsis** button.


2. Select **View patient details**.
