

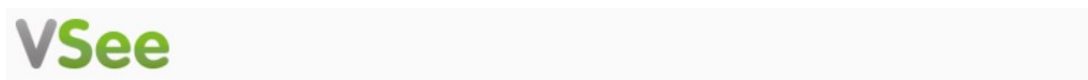
How to Delete Your VSee Messenger Account

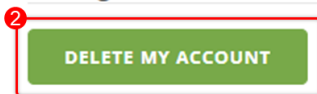
2. Once logged in, click on **DELETE MY ACCOUNT**.

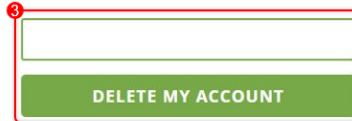
