### 1. No more downloads: Stress-free in-browser calling

Ever had trouble getting a patient to download VSee on their first video visit? We are taking that stress out of connecting online. Try our new in-browser video calling experience. **This means patients don't need to download any VSee apps on their device!**\* Just a quick, simple sign-in and they are ready to go!

For providers, the video will be embedded right on the same page as your patient notes, history, etc., so you can be in and out of your call without any fuss. No more need to spend time arranging your windows.

VSee Clinic call reports will also include phone call-ins and in-browser video meetings.

Please note that the in-browser VSee does not yet allow for screenshare annotations or video recording.

\*Currently supported only for Chrome and Firefox on desktop. Not supported on any mobile browser. We are looking into supporting other web browsers and on mobile but no ETA yet. For mobile, using the VSee Clinic app still provides the best patient experience.


